Public Transit Infrastructure Grants



- Program created by 2006 General Assembly
 - Can fund vertical infrastructure for public transit
 - Projects should be capable of completion in 18 months
- 2008 General Assembly appropriated a third year of funding from bond revenues

Public Transit Infrastructure Grants



- Funds available = \$2,200,000 new
49,536 carryover
\$2,249,536
- Commission approved 4 projects July, 2008 for \$1,782,240
- Applications for remaining FY09 funds were received October 1st
