

## **PIN – Program Improvement Number**

Number used to identify a segment of roadway that has been entered into the Five Year Program. An example is shown below:

PIN: 07-85-020-010-02

07	2-digit year the segment entered the Five Year Program
85	2-digit county number
020	3-digit route number
010	3-digit number representing a unique sequence of the assignment of segments in a given county and route
02	2-digit section number representing a subdivision of a segment into smaller pieces. This portion of the PIN may or may not exist depending on if a segment needs to be subdivided or not.

Note: All portions of the PIN must contain the appropriate number of significant digits. Include 0s preceding the numbers as needed. For example, the route number for Highway 20 is 020.
