
108-18B Concrete Barrier at Side Locations

A number of BA Standard Road Plans state that “Expansion Joints are necessary only where specifically required by project plans.” To clarify, expansion joints are required in the following situations:

1. If there is an expansion joint in the pavement below the barrier, such as in a bridge approach section, or
2. If the barrier is butting into a separate structure, such as a bridge pier, sign truss footing, bridge rail, etc.
