


GUIDE SIGNS



THE ALUMINUM z SHALL NEVER EXTEND BELOW THE BOTTOM OF THE MAJOR SIGN.


REAR VIEW

NOTE:
1. IF THE BOLT HOLES IN THE TOP PANEL AND THE BOTTOM PANEL OF THE TWO SIGNS LINE UP, PANEL BOLTS ARE TO BE USED.

2. IF THE ANGLE FASTENERS CAN NOT BE HORIZONTALLY PLACED AS SHOWN, THEY CAN BE MOVED SO AS TO SECURELY HOLD THE TOP SIGN.

NOTE:
The EXIT NUMBER PANEL shall normally be positioned above the guide sign aligned with the edge of the guide sign indicating direction of exit.

EXIT GORE SIGNS



NOTE: THE EXIT PANEL SHALL BE CENTERED ABOVE M9-2.
