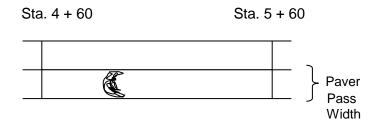

## **Price Adjustment for Segregation Examples**

Case I Visual Segregation – 1 sq. yd. or more / station

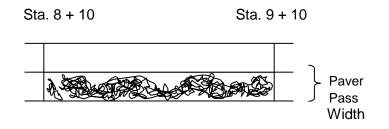


Surface Course

Mix Price Adjustment: 20%

Base & Intermediate Course Mix Price Adjustment: 5%

Case II Visual Segregation – 3 sq. yd. or more (total) / station

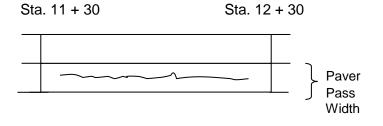


Surface Course

Mix Price Adjustment: 50%

Base & Intermediate Course Mix Price Adjustment: 5%

Case III Visual Segregation (Longitudinal Streaks) – 1 sq. yd. or more / station



Surface Course

Mix Price Adjustment: 20%

Base & Intermediate Course Mix Price Adjustment: 5%

## Application of Price Adjustment

The price adjustment applies to the entire area defined by the length times the paving width where this condition exists. For example, if a **Case I** condition exists for a Surface Course, which was paved for a length of 20 stations, paver width at 12 ft., paving depth of 2 inches, and the unit price for HMA Surface mix at \$20.00 per ton:

Price Adjustment = (20%)(1/100)(20 stations)(100 ft./1 station)(2 in.)(1 ft./12 in.)(12 ft.) (145 lbs./cu. ft.)(1ton/2000 lbs.)(\$20.00/ton)

= \$1160.00
