Funding

State Recreational Trails
Program

- \$1 million per year
- \$18 million spent on trails since 1989



FundingFederal Transportation

\$5 million per year

Enhancement Program

 \$58 million spent on lowa trails since 1994



Funding

Federal Recreational Trails Program

- \$0.8 million per year
- \$7 million spent on Iowa trails since 1993

Bicycle accommodations on state highways

Guidance adopted in 1999



- Planning Policies for paved shoulders and rumble strips
 - Received input from bicycle advisory committee
 - Effective July 2003
 - All state highways will have paved shoulders
