The Midwestern Pavement Preservation Partnership (MPPP) Annual Meeting will be held in Des Moines from October 25 – 28. MPPP is an American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO) supported regional organization of state, local, and federal government officials as well as contractors and suppliers. The focus of the group is to provide a forum to share information, identify common issues, share specifications, and promote the benefits of pavement preservation. Sharing experiences on a regional level allows participants to learn about other state's preservation programs. This provides the opportunity to see what treatments work in other states, develop more consistent specifications, select effective treatments, and improve the overall quality of the preservation projects that are constructed. As greater emphasis is being placed on maintaining the roadway system, this meeting provides an opportunity to learn what is happening in pavement preservation at both the regional and national level.
