Please review all of your proposed projects that will use Farm-to-Market (FM) funds, in whole or in part, especially those that are candidates for the possible second Federal stimulus program funds. It is **extremely important** that your project information is correct and complete, including the most current cost estimate and all proposed funding sources. Please review and update your information as soon as you can.

All proposed stimulus projects submitted to the planning agencies for funding need to be activated in TPMS as soon as possible so we can use that information to predict anticipated FM obligations. Despite the Iowa DOT's encouragement for planning agencies to fully fund stimulus candidates, it is apparent that many did not. We will continue to review the TPMS project information to determine if the current borrowing restrictions are adequate.
