SUBJECT: Closure Date for ER Event IA-10-02 – **Correction**

DATE: September 24, 2010

Note: This memo is to correct and update the memo sent on September 21. First, the **emergency repairs must be completed within 180 days**, not 90 days as previously stated. Second, **three additional counties have been added to this event; Greene, Harrison and Page**. These are shown on the updated map linked below.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has established a closure date for the subject Emergency Relief (ER) program event. This event began on June 1, and continued through September 7, 2010. The current version of the IA-10-02 event map is available at:

The closure date is important because it sets a time limit for emergency repairs to be completed and remain eligible for 100% reimbursement. Emergency repairs must be completed within 180 days of the disaster, in this case, March 6, 2011. Please remember that emergency repairs are limited to those necessary to restore essential traffic, minimize the extent of damage, or to protect the remaining facilities. These repairs can begin immediately following a disaster, and prior FHWA approval is not required.
