Governor Branstad's disaster emergency proclamation adds Clinton County

Addition of Clinton County brings number of counties in disaster emergencies to nine

(DES MOINES) – Governor Terry E. Branstad today added Clinton County to a disaster emergency proclamation in response to last week's severe winter weather.

The Governor's proclamation allows state resources to be utilized to respond to and recover from the effects of these storms, including for removal of snow.

This is the ninth county that has been declared by Gov. Branstad related to last week's storm.

Counties declared disaster emergencies related to last week's storm are: Cedar, Clinton, Delaware, Dubuque, Jackson, Johnson, Jones, Lee and Scott counties.
