All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to discuss the proposed Portland cement concrete reconstruction of U.S. 63 from south of Iowa 58 in Hudson north to U.S. 20 in Waterloo.

Iowa DOT staff will be available anytime between 5:30 and 7:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed improvements. A formal presentation will be made at 6 p.m.

Traffic would be detoured during construction of the segment of U.S. 63 south of Iowa 58, using Black Hawk County roads D-46 and D-35 and Iowa 21; and the segment north of Iowa 58, using Iowa 58 and U.S. 20.
