to discuss proposed culvert replacement on
U.S. 6 in Ladora, Iowa County

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5 and 6 p.m. to discuss the proposed culvert replacement on U.S. 6 over an unnamed stream in Ladora, in Iowa County. Included in the project is reconstruction of the sidewalk on the south side of the roadway to provide for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards; grading for a future sidewalk on the north side of the roadway; and associated reconstruction of the adjacent roadway. The existing sidewalk on the south side would be closed during construction.

The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.
