PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Thursday, Feb. 16, 2017, 5 to 6:30 p.m.

The Iowa Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting Thursday, Feb. 16, to discuss the proposed improvements and right of way needs along U.S. 151 from south of Church Street in Fairfax to south of Dean Road Southwest in Cedar Rapids. The projects concentrate on the replacement of four U.S. 151 bridges over the Union Pacific Railroad's property, Prairie Creek, drainage ditch 2.5 miles south of U.S. 30, and the drainage ditch 0.6 mile south of U.S. 30. At some locations, the roadway approaching the structures will be reconstructed to include three lanes.

During construction, through traffic will be detoured out of the corridor while providing local access to properties, businesses, and the city of Fairfax.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.

The meeting space is accessible for persons with disabilities. However, if you require special accommodations at the meeting, please notify the Iowa DOT contact listed to the left by Feb. 13.
