**Oelwein Public Library, 201 East Charles St.**

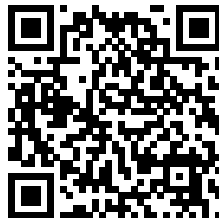
All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to discuss the proposed patching, widening and resurfacing of Iowa 3 throughout the project limits.

No formal presentation will be made at the meeting. Iowa DOT staff will be available anytime between 5 and 7 p.m. to individually discuss the proposed improvement.
