The Iowa Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting to discuss the proposed improvement on U.S. 20 from Webster County Road P-59 east to the west junction of Iowa 17 in Hamilton County. The proposed improvement is scheduled to take place in two phases: 1) Webster County roads P-59 to just east of P-73 will be done in 2016; and 2) east of Webster County Road P-73 to the west junction of Iowa 17, in Hamilton County, would be tentatively completed in the next five years.

U.S. 20 traffic will be maintained during construction. Side road at-grade intersections will be closed and traffic detoured during construction. Traffic at the westbound ramps of the west Iowa 17 interchange will be detoured to the east Iowa 17 interchange at Webster City.

The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvement. No formal presentation will be made.
