to discuss two proposed projects on Iowa 117 in Jasper County

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to discuss two proposed projects on Iowa 117 in Jasper County.

The first project involves bank stabilization along Indian Creek just east of Iowa 117 near Mingo. Traffic will be maintained during construction. The second project involves replacing two small bridge structures with reinforced box culverts on Iowa 117 located approximately 1.2 miles south of the U.S. 65/Iowa 330/Iowa 117 intersection. Four detour options will be presented for this project.

No formal presentation will be made. Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) staff will be available anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. to individually discuss the proposed improvements.
