to discuss I-74 road construction from Moline
to Davenport

The Iowa and Illinois departments of Transportation will host two public informational meetings to discuss the impacts and timing of Interstate 74 road construction from Avenue of the Cities in Moline, Ill., to 53rd Street in Davenport, Iowa. A major component of this project is the replacement of the current I-74 river bridges. The upcoming 2014-2015 advance work in downtown Bettendorf, Iowa, and Moline will also be discussed.

All interested persons are invited to attend either meeting anytime between 4 and 7 p.m. The same information will be presented during the two meetings:

- Wednesday, April 23, at the I-Wireless Center, 1201 River Drive, in Moline.
- Thursday, April 24, at The Quad-Cities Waterfront Convention Center, 2021 State St., in Bettendorf.

Both meetings will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT and Illinois DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.
