All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to discuss the proposed resurfacing of Iowa 4, south of Pomeroy in Calhoun County to 0.2 mile north of the Iowa 7 junction in Pocahontas County.

During resurfacing, Iowa 4 traffic would be detoured under CN's railroad overpass using Third Street, Ontario Street and Center Street in Pomeroy.

No formal presentation will be made. Iowa DOT staff will be available anytime between 5 and 7 p.m. to individually discuss the proposed improvement.
