An environmental assessment was previously completed in 2004 for this corridor. Iowa DOT staff is proposing modifications to the preferred alternative in the vicinity of the intersection of U.S. 20 with Iowa 32 (Northwest Arterial).

No formal presentation will be made. Iowa DOT staff will be available anytime between 4 and 6 p.m. to individually discuss the proposed interchanges.
