The Iowa Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting to discuss an Interstate 80 corridor study area that extends from east of Iowa City, approximately 1.5 miles west of Herbert Hoover Highway, east of West Branch at Charles Avenue, in Johnson and Cedar counties.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. in the Schwab Auditorium at the Coralville Public Library, 1401 Fifth St., in Coralville.
