All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed resurfacing on U.S. 65 from the Wayne/Lucas county line north to U.S. 34. The improvement also includes pavement widening, partial shoulder paving and updating guardrail.

Traffic would be detoured during construction using U.S. 34, Iowa 14 and Iowa 2. (For more information, see the website listed below.)

The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.
