All interested persons are invited to attend this public meeting anytime between 5 and 6:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed concrete overlay on U.S. 65 from the Wayne and Lucas county line north to U.S. 34. The improvement also includes pavement widening, partial shoulder paving, and updating guardrail.

The meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff and the selected contractor for this project will be present to informally discuss the proposed improvements. No formal presentation will be made.

Traffic would be detoured during a portion of construction using U.S. 34, Iowa 14, and Iowa 2. (For more information, see the website listed below.)
