The Iowa Department of Transportation will hold a public information meeting Tuesday, Sept. 22, to discuss the proposed improvements to Iowa 38 from U.S. 30 to the north Stanwood city limits in Cedar County.

Iowa 38 within the city limits of Stanwood will be closed to through traffic during construction. Traffic will follow a detour using U.S. 30, Iowa 1, and U.S. 151.

This public information meeting will be conducted utilizing an open forum format. Iowa DOT staff will be available to informally discuss the proposed improvement. No formal presentation will be made.
