Questions and Answers Set 1

1. Who supplies the material for the wall preparation?

Contractor. The DOT supplies the paint

2. Will the DOT remove and move all items not fixed to walls?

Yes, the DOT will move all items not fixed to walls. DOT will remove miscellaneous items hanging on the walls

Contractor will prep and tape for outlets, blank covers, switched, ductwork, around counter tops and cabinets, corner guards and vinyl base.

All prep materials will be provided by contractor.

All painted areas are provided on the specifications for each area.

3. Will the lettering be removed on the Administration Canopy?

No, you will need to prep and paint around them

4. Can we use Rustoleum primer for the areas that are rusted?

Yes, provide that on your materials list for paint

5. Is week-end painting allowed?

The Admin Canopy will need to be painted after hours/week-end.

Some week-end painting will be allowed per approval of Ashley Smelser. Please indicate the amount of hours on the Schedule of Prices.

6. Are progress payments allowed?

Yes, we will allow progress payments per Item 1-4 for job completion.

7. Will the Lab hoods be removed? Is there a concern for painting in the lab?
