RESOLUTION SUPPORTING TIME-21 PROGRAM (TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENT MOVES THE ECONOMY IN THE 21ST CENTURY)

WHEREAS, THE Road Use Tax Fund is an important source of support for construction and maintenance project at the city, county and state level; and

WHEREAS, an integral part of that R.U.T.F. is the fuel tax, which has not increased since 1989, and during that timeframe construction costs have more than doubled; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Supervisor's Association, the Iowa County Engineer's Association, the Iowa League of Cities, Professional Developers of Iowa, and a consortium of additional public and private individuals and organizations, have promoted the TIME-21 program (Transportation Investment Moves the Economy in the 21st Century) to underscore the steady deterioration of the construction dollar; and

WHEREAS, TIME-21 supports the Iowa Department of Transportation's request for an additional \$200 million added to the R.U.T.F. that would be committed to roadway infrastructure and would be generated by increasing transportation-related fees;




