

RESOLUTION NO. 10-08**A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE LEGISLATURE TO CONSIDER FUNDING ALTERNATIVES TO INCREASE REVENUE TO THE ROAD USE TAX FUND.**

WHEREAS, the Road Use Tax Fund is an important source of support for construction and maintenance projects at the city, county and state level; and


WHEREAS, an integral part of that R.U.T.F. is the fuel tax, which has not increased since 1989, and during that timeframe construction costs have more than doubled; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Supervisor's Association, the Iowa County Engineer's Association, the Iowa League of Cities, Professional Developers of Iowa, and a consortium of additional public and private individuals and organizations, have promoted the TIME-21 program (Transportation Investment Moves the Economy in the 21st Century) to underscore that steady deterioration of the construction dollar; and


WHEREAS, TIME-21 supports the Iowa Department of Transportation's request for an additional \$200 million added to the R.U.T.F. that would be committed to roadway infrastructure and would be generated by increasing transportation-related fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Independence, Iowa, recognizes the vital role that our transportation system performs for Iowa and encourages the legislature to consider funding alternatives to increase revenue to the Road Use Tax Fund.
