CONTEST RULES

All photos should have an Iowa public transit connection. Whether your photos represent rural or urban transit, mobility management, employee transportation, medical transportation, customer service, facilities, vehicles, bus stops or another category, we want to see and share your transit photography!

All entries must be submitted by June 1, 2013. Three winners will be announced June 19, at the Iowa Public Transit Association Annual Meeting. There is no limit to the number of photos an entrant may submit. Only digital entries will be accepted. Digital photos should be taken at the highest resolution possible. Iowa DOT employees and immediate family members are not eligible for the contest. Photos will be judged by the Iowa DOT's Office of Public Transit, based on impression and visual creativity.

Each image **should** include a description (i.e., who, what, where, when, why).

AWARDS

Winners will receive a certificate of recognition, an invitation to the Iowa Public Transit Training Meeting awards luncheon and acknowledgements through a statewide announcement on the Iowa DOT's Office of Public Transit website and Iowa Public Transit Association's Facebook page.

REPRODUCTION RIGHTS

Entries may be used to promote public transit in Iowa. All entries are subject to unlimited, royalty-free use by the Iowa DOT, and may be used without permission or credit. CDs will not be returned.
