

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Regional Transit Authority
RIDES

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) dba RIDES at its headquarters at, 522 10th Ave East, Spencer, IA, at 10:30 a.m. on March 19, 2015. The purpose of this hearing is to discuss an application from the RTA to the Iowa Department of Transportation for financial assistance as follows:

RTA will request approximately \$468,689.00 of State Transit Assistance funds and approximately \$452,828.00 of Federal Transit Assistance funds for fiscal year 2016.

RTA wishes to purchase Three ADA Accessible 176'' wheel base Light Duty Bus with surveillance at \$78,200 each which is at 85% of the federal share and \$13,800 each which is 15% of the local share for a total of \$92,000. Grand total for these three buses is \$234,600. RTA would also purchase Four ADA Accessible 158'' wheel base Light duty Bus with Surveillance at \$73,950, which is at 85% of the federal share and \$13,050 which is at 15% of the local share for a grand total of \$295,800. RTA plans to purchase one ADA Accessible Mini-Van with surveillance at \$44,625 which is 85% federal share and \$7,875 which is at 15% of the local share, for a total of \$52,500.

These projects will not have a significant detrimental environmental effect on the area, and no persons or businesses will be displaced by these activities. The projects are in conformance with the Statewide Transit Improvement Program (STIP).

Any interested person or agency is invited to attend this hearing and speak for or against this application for funding.
