NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TO ALL TAXPAYERS OF THE IOWA CITY URBANIZED AREA AND TO OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Public notice is hereby given that the University of Iowa will conduct a public hearing on the University's FY13 Iowa DOT Consolidated Transit Funding grant application. The application will be for approximately \$521,371 (5.032707%) in State Transit Assistance formula funds to be used for operating and/or purchasing capital items for University of Iowa CAMBUS during FY13. Said application will also include a listing of projects to be applied for in FY13 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307, Section 5309, Section 5310, Section 5316, and/or Section 5317 programs. The FTA Section 5307 program provides federal funds to be used for the operating and capital needs of University of Iowa CAMBUS. Section 5309 is a discretionary capital funding program and Section 5310 provides funds for programs targeting persons with special needs. Section 5316 funds are to assist programs oriented to the transportation needs of low income and/or persons with disabilities related to employment. Section 5317 funds are for programs that go beyond minimums established by ADA. Section 5307, Section 5309, Section 5310, Section 5316, and/or Section 5317 projects to be applied for in FY13 include (total cost and federal amount):

The public hearing will be held at 11:00 a.m. on April 27, 2012, at the Metropolitan Planning Organization of Johnson County (MPOJC) Transportation Planning Division office, 410 E. Washington Street, Iowa City, Iowa.

A preliminary application will be on file April 1, 2012, at the MPOJC Transportation Planning Division Office, and may be inspected by interested persons.
