PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Siouxland Regional Transit System (SRTS) at the SRTS office, 1122 Pierce Street, Sioux City, Iowa at 10:45 a.m., on May 21, 2015. The purpose for this hearing is to consider the operating assistance from the Federal Transit Administration and Iowa Department of Transportation for Iowa State Transit Assistance 49 U.S.C. Section 5316 and 49 U.S.C. Section 5317 for fiscal year 2016.

The Siouxland Regional Transit System (SRTS) will pursue operating funds for one year from the Iowa Department of Transportation for Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) 5316 funding and New Freedom 5317 funding in the total amount of \$70,000, federal \$56,000 and local funds of \$14,000. These funds will be used for a Mobility Management Coordinator who will provide a centralized coordination of both the human service and public transportation systems and volunteer transportation programs.

The project will have no significant environmental impact on this area, and no persons, families or businesses will be displaced by this transit project. The project is in conformance with the 2016 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program. Unless amended, the initial Program of Projects will become the final Program of Projects.
