1. Jan – 150 people attended last week's meeting – need to finish prioritizing.
2. Jeremy - Meeting was Wednesday and half day on Thursday. Data and research needs also came up. People want more information to make assessments. Committee to create additional data sets.
  - a. Wednesday meeting – how much traffic is fleet traffic and miles in a given year. Large enough percent then target information.
  - b. Inattentive/Distracted drivers – need information defined, not defined now in crash data.
  - c. Senate file 33 – distracted driving law. Current texting law is currently difficult to enforce,
  - d. Article of mom's driving with young children, so has to be more than just texting defined.
  - e. Freight companies have problems with everything being negative marks and nothing positive on reports. From enforcement standpoint – has to be secondary offense....need to have a reason to stop first.
