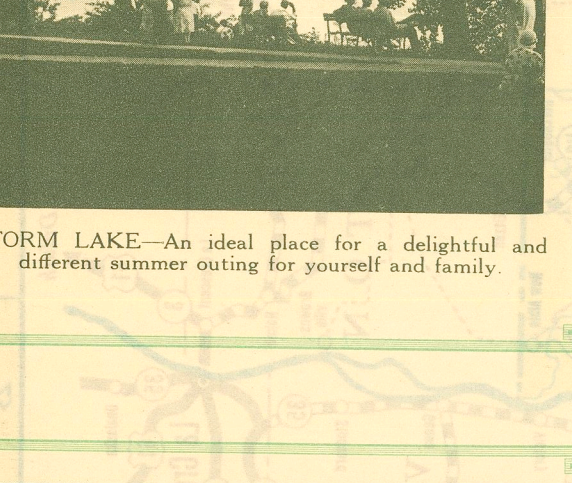

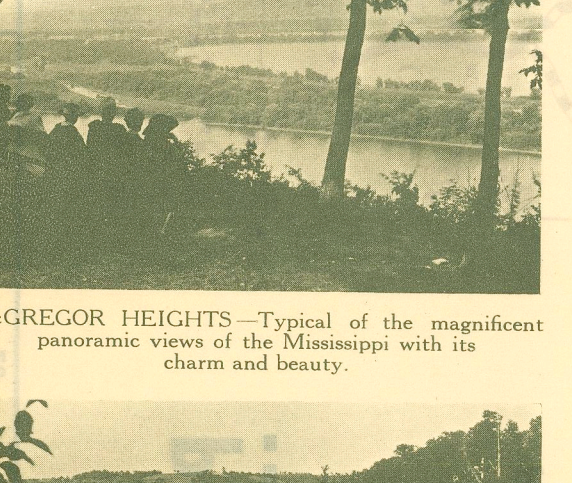
WEST OKOBOJI—One of the most beautiful blue-water lakes of the world. Part of "The Iowa Great Lakes."



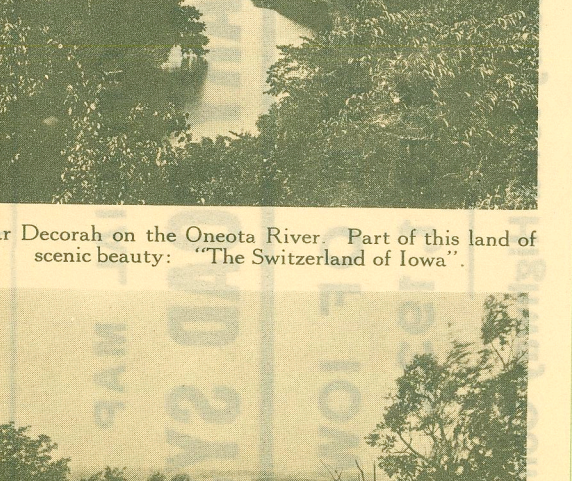
CLEAR LAKE—A clear, cold-water lake popular as a summer resort.



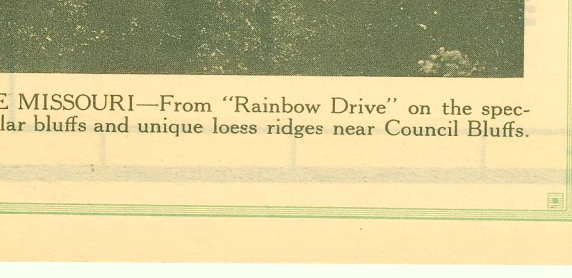

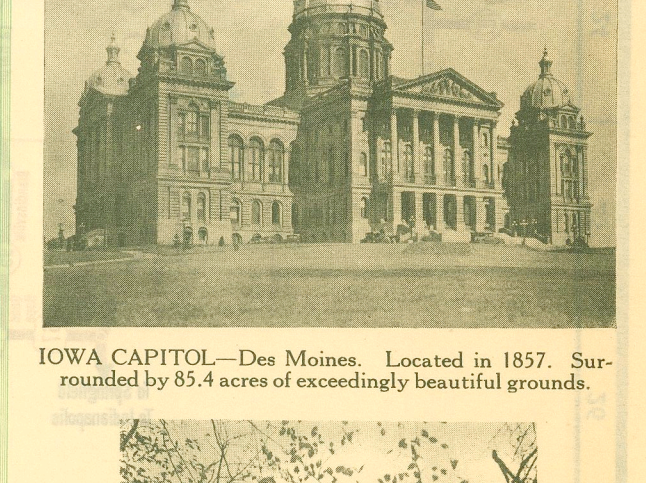
OLD CAPITOL—University of Iowa, Iowa City. The first state house of Iowa.



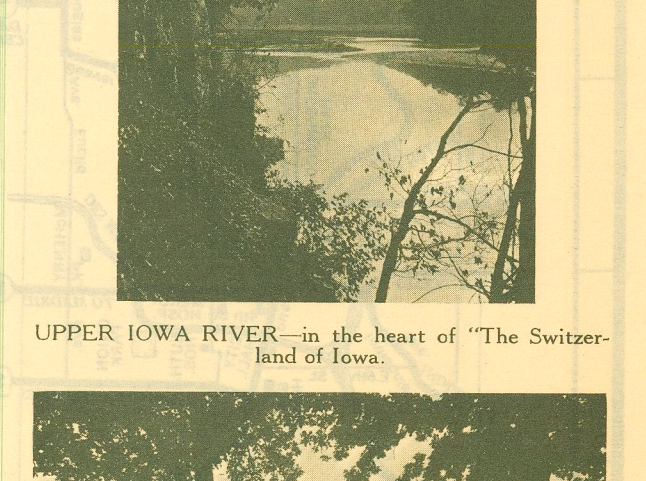
CENTRAL BUILDING—Iowa State Park, Ames. At the heart of a college and campus landscape.
