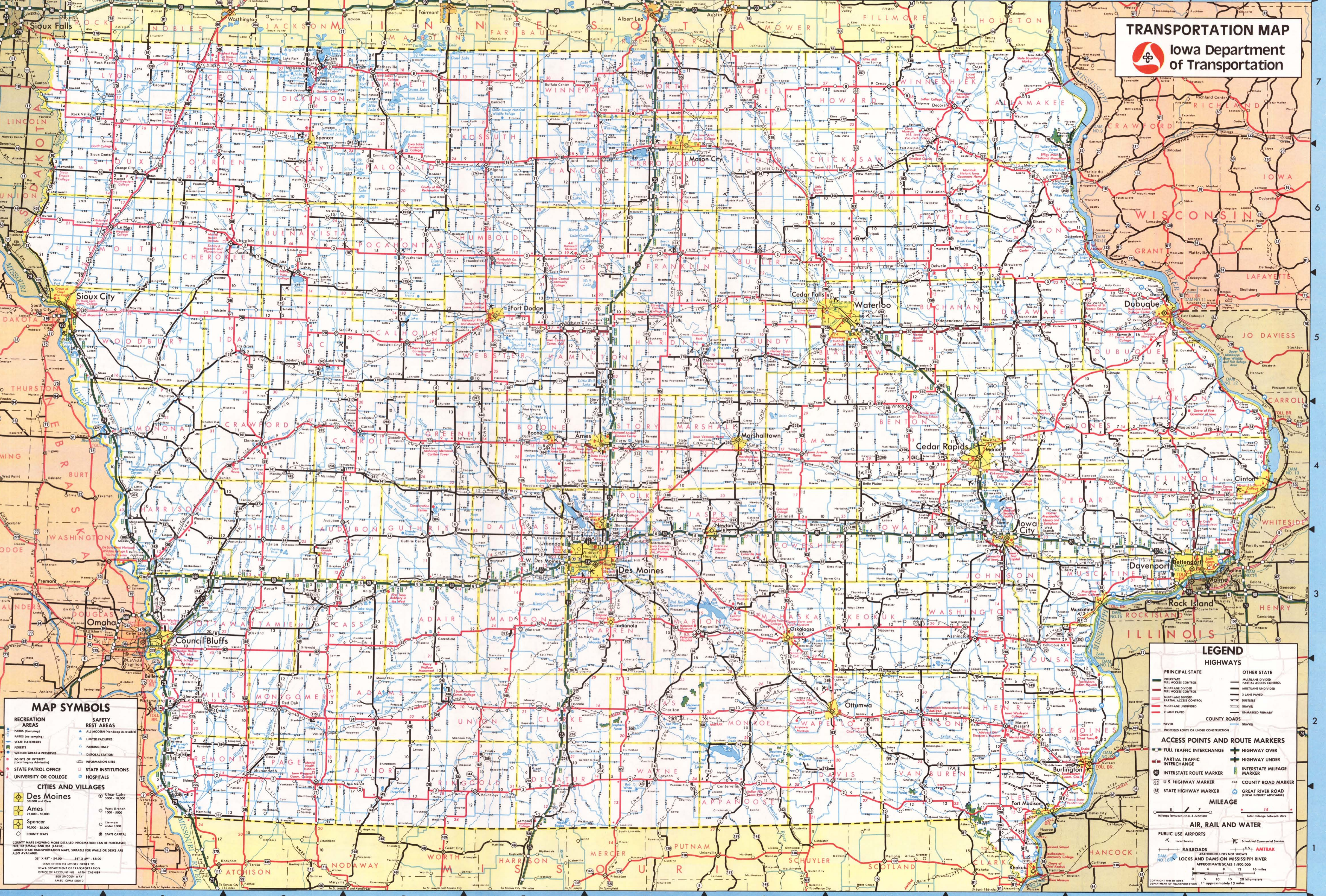


TRANSPORTATION MAP

CAR TROUBLE—Drive off traffic roadway to an emergency area (shoulder), turn on emergency flashers. Raise car antenna and tie a cloth to car antenna or door handle. Passing motorists should render help if possible or notify law enforcement officers. ACCIDENTS—Notify law enforcement officers if there are injuries, death or damage to property upon or adjacent to the highway. Do not leave the accident scene, provide assistance to the injured. Submit written report within three days to Motor Vehicle Division Iowa D.O.T. Report forms are available from local police departments, county sheriffs or state patrol.
