**New Life Center, St. Paul's United Methodist Church, 207 W. Louise St., Waterloo**

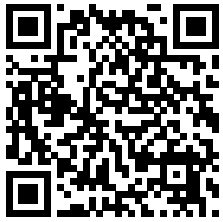
