The project replaced failing ties for about a mile of the existing track, starting at Harrison St. and extending 650 feet beyond Meridian St. in the city of Boone, Boone County. The original project cost was \$734,816 and original loan request was \$511,112. Due to a substantial increase in bid vs estimates, the project was scaled back to a loan request of \$391,416. This project finished under budget and supports continued growth leveraging rail access to the industrial park on the East side of Boone.
